

Marine Landing Day Camp 2023 Frequently Asked Questions

Camp is full! How can I get on a waiting list?

Email registration@girlscoutsla.org with camper(s) name, desired camp, and desired sessions.

Do I have to be a Girl Scout to attend camp?

If a camper is not currently a Girl Scout, a one-time \$25 annual membership fee will be applied, in addition to your total camp fees. As members, Girl Scouts can join a Girl Scouts troop and/or participate in an array of councilsponsored programs located across Greater Los Angeles during year.

Is financial aid available?

Yes, financial aid "camperships" are available for campers whose family financial circumstances might otherwise prevent them from attending camp. Interested applicants must submit a *LINK*Campership Application <u>before</u> registering.

What does a normal day of camp look like?

Daily activities include themed-related games and/or crafts, free swim and boating rotations, and badgework. Unit chants/cheers, flag ceremonies, and GS songs/skits break up the activity blocks throughout the day.

What is the Monday swim evaluation?

Every Monday, campers are required to participate in a swim evaluation. Water competency is measured by a camper's ability to swim to the furthest swim boundary and back to shore without experiencing fatigue or distress.
