Frequently Asked Questions

Who Can Participate in GSGLA Program Activities, Events, and Camps?

Any registered Girl Scout can participate in GSGLA activities, events and camps. Not registered as a Girl Scout? It's easy to join. The annual membership fee is just \$12. There are several pathways into Girl Scouting and a variety of activities, events, and camps for girls of all ages and with various interests. Girls and their friends can become involved with Girl Scouts even if they are not involved with a traditional troop. For more information about joining Girl Scouts, contact a membership team member at the Service Center nearest you or visit our website at www.girlscoutsla.org.

How do I register for program activities/events/camps?

Go to www.girlscoutsla.org, click on the Activities & Events tab, then click on Calendar, and either check out the calendar by date or use one of the search options to find the activity, event, or camp that meets your interests, location or grade level! When you click on an event, you'll link to more details and registration information. Registration can either be completed via fax, email, mail, or over the counter by downloading and filling out a paper registration form or through our new online registration system. We encourage you to register online as it will be more efficient and provides real-time registration confirmation. In order to register, you must create an account using the email address provided during your membership registration. If do not remember the email address provided, please contact your local Girl Scout office. You must have an email address to register online! All payments will be due at the time of registration.

Should my Girl Scout/s participate in the annual Cookie Program?

The annual Girl Scout Cookie Program is the nation's leading financial literacy program for girls! Through the cookie program, girls gain self-confidence and courage, as well as skills related to goal setting, money management, marketing and teamwork. Numerous successful women across the country have indicated that their experience in selling cookies as Girl Scouts helped prepare them for their current roles in business. Participating in the Cookie Program today helps girls prepare for tomorrow! Camps & Camping

GSGLA offers an ACA accredited resident camp at Camp Osito Rancho in Big Bear during the month of July. A range of sessions are offered for girls (grades 2 and above) that challenge their skills, expand their environmental awareness, create opportunities for friendships, and ultimately allow them to have FUN! Counselor-in-Training (CIT) sessions are also available for older girls.

Day camps are offered in various areas across Greater Los Angeles and provide week-long opportunities throughout the summer for girls in grades K-6 (please check the website for specific camp sessions related to age appropriateness). Program Aide opportunities exist for Cadette, Senior, and Ambassador Girl Scouts interested in working with younger girls through our day camps who have completed sixth grade, Core Training and camp specialty trainings. Additional core camping and overnight camping experiences exist. Please check the Activities & Events tab at girlscoutsla.org or look for our 2011-2012 Camp Guide (published late winter/early spring) for GSGLA sponsored camps!

Gold, Silver, and Bronze Awards

These awards are the highest that Girl Scouts can earn at their respective program levels. Junior Girl Scouts can earn the Bronze Award, which is presented and received by girls at the troop level. Cadette Girl Scouts can earn the Silver Award, which is presented and received by girls at council hosted ceremonies. Senior and Ambassador Girl Scouts can earn the Gold Award, which is presented and received by girls at the annual GSGLA Gold Award Ceremony.
