

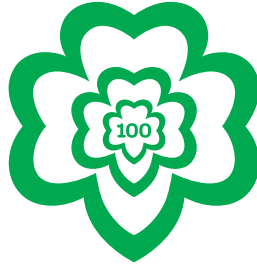

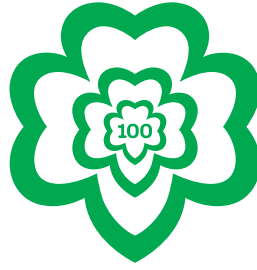

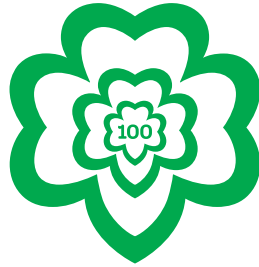
Rose Parade Viewing/Tickets

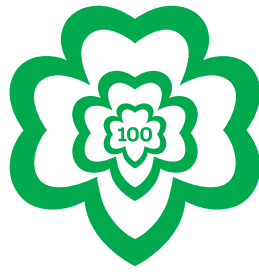
Getting There

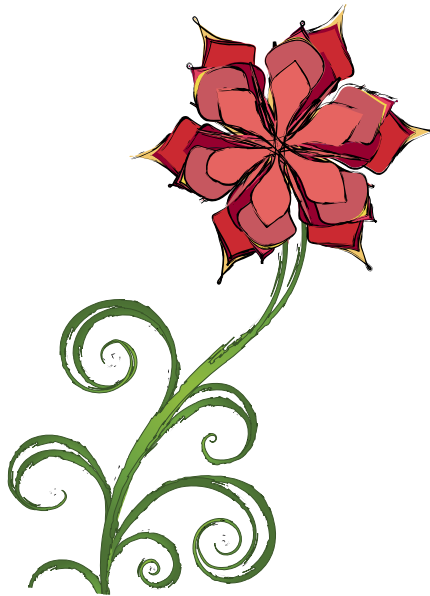
