Good Turn Days is a fun community service project for Girl Scouts to collect gently used clothing and other items for donation to Goodwill Southern California. Girls will earn a Good Turn Day patch.

How Troops Participate in Good Turn Day:

- Step 1** Collect items for donation.
- Step 2** Drop off items to Goodwill Retail Stores during Good Turn Week. (Ask for a receipt)
- Step 3** Complete Patch Order Form and bring the form and receipt to your local Girl Scouts of Greater Los Angeles Regional Office

How your participation helps Goodwill and your community:

- By collecting goods that might otherwise end up in the landfill, Girl Scouts will be helping the environment!
- Collected goods will be resold to benefit Goodwill's programs that provide training and jobs for jobseekers.
- Raise awareness about Goodwill's mission to assist people with disabilities and others in need.

What is accepted: Gently-used clothing, small working electronics, computers, TVs, kitchen gadgets, pots, pans, jewelry, toys, games, furniture, etc.

What is not accepted: Soiled, stained or torn clothing; appliances, paint, chemicals, auto parts, mattresses, etc. (If you are unsure about your donation, please call your nearest Goodwill store using the list provided.)
