Communicate to those at risk of exposure • Close off areas used by the confirmed positive case and do not use these areas until after cleaning and disinfecting them (for outdoor areas, this includes surfaces or shared objects in the area, if applicable). Ventilate the area as much as possible with open screened windows and doors and then enter to clean and disinfect the space.
