

Overview

As GSUSA completes the creation of dedicated sub-accounts for each council, the settings for each user group within each sub-account have been evaluated to ensure they are as safe as possible for our council partners, volunteers, and girls. Below are the major settings that have been locked by GSUSA and cannot be modified by end users. If a setting is not on this list of “locked” settings, then any user can change the setting on their own personal account as they see fit.

Scheduled Meetings

Settings	Description	Volunteer
<i>Enable Personal Meeting ID</i>	A Personal Meeting ID (PMI) is a 9 to 11 digit number that is assigned to your account	OFF - LOCKED
<i>Use Personal Meeting ID (PMI) when scheduling a meeting</i>	You can visit Personal Meeting Room to change your Personal Meeting settings	OFF - LOCKED
<i>Use Personal Meeting ID (PMI) when starting an instant meeting</i>	PMI is used when instant meeting is selected	OFF - LOCKED
<i>Require a password when scheduling new meetings</i>	Note: The file shared with Zoom for identification must have audio of at least 2 minutes in length.	ON - LOCKED
<i>Require a password for instant meetings</i>	A random password will be generated when starting an instant meeting	ON - LOCKED
<i>Embed password in meeting link for one-click join</i>	Meeting password will be encrypted and included in the invite link to allow participants to join with just one click without having to enter the password.	OFF - LOCKED
<i>Require password for participants joining by phone</i>	A numeric password will be required for participants joining by phone if your meeting has a password. For meeting with an alphanumeric password, a numeric version will be generated.	ON - LOCKED

Settings	Description	Volunteer
Show Zoom windows during screen share	Enable sharing of Zoom window when sharing screen.	OFF-LOCKED
Who can start sharing when someone else is sharing?	Host Only OR All Participants	Host Only-LOCKED
Allow removed participants to rejoin	Allows previously removed meeting participants and webinar panelists to rejoin	OFF-LOCKED

Advanced

Settings	Description	Volunteer
Far end camera control	Allow another user to take control of your camera during a meeting	OFF-LOCKED
Identify guest participants in the meeting/webinar	Participants who belong to your account can see that a guest (someone who does not belong to your account) is participating in the meeting/webinar. The Participants list indicates which attendees are guests. The guests themselves do not see that they are listed as guests.	ON-LOCKED
Waiting room	When participants join a meeting, place them in a waiting room and require the host to admit them individually. Enabling the waiting room automatically disables the setting for allowing participants to join before host.	ON-LOCKED Selection: Users not in your account and Host and co-host only
