- Girls sell Girl Scout Cookies to earn proceeds to support their fun activities and Take Action goals.
- From Feb-March, Girl Scouts offer nine varieties of cookies including a gluten free option. This year, Girl Scouts has a new cookie for customers to try: Exploremores!

How do Girl Scouts benefit from participation?

- Building confidence while having fun.
- Gain essential life skills like goal setting, decision making, money management, people skills and business ethics.
- Experience personal growth in leadership and goal accomplishment.

- Troops earn \$1 per package of cookies sold.
- Cadette, Senior, and Ambassador troops may decide to opt out of rewards in order to earn an additional \$.10 per package.
- Girl Scouts earn individual rewards based on the number of packages sold.
- In addition to physical rewards, Girl Scouts can earn reward events, like an outing with the CEO.

What is needed to participate?

- Current Girl Scout membership.
- Identified Troop Cookie Chair and have completed service unit training.
- Have a troop bank account opened.
- Parents/caregivers must submit a Permission and Responsibility Agreement for their Girl Scout(s).
