Decision Making

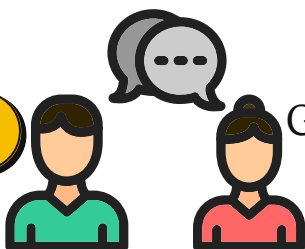
Girl Scouts learn to make decisions on their own and as a team, whether it's how to run and promote their business, interact with customers, or spend their earnings.
