



Fall Product Chair

Role Description

- Troop Fall Product Chairs (TFPC) manage troop participation in the Fall Product Program.
- Work with the Troop Leader & Service Unit Fall Product Chair (SUFPC) by promoting, coordinating and conducting troop Fall Product Program activities.
- Encourage participation of all currently registered girls to incorporate the Fall Product Program as a meaningful part of the Girl Scout leadership development program.

Requirements

- Must be current registered adult member of GSUSA.
- Must have a current background check.
- Complete training.

Responsibilities

- **Forms:** Collect signed Parent Agreement forms for each Girl Scout who is participating in the program.
- **Training:** Attend Service Unit training and train your troop families.
- **Support Participating Families :** Answer questions throughout the program. Forward communications from GSLA Product Programs team to parents/caregivers. Make sure families are collecting orders and submitting them on time.
- **Review Orders:** Review and submit troop's nut and candy orders by the due date. Complete any troop-to-troop product transfers and make sure all products have been assigned to girls.
- **Distribution:** Pick up your troop's order from your service unit, and distribute to Girl Scouts.
- **Program Wrap Up:** Plan Delivery day. Review, receive, and distribute rewards.

Time Commitment

September to November is the most concentrated time commitment.
