## GUIDELINES: COMMUNITY PARTNER LETTER OF SUPPORT

Please remember that only TYPED materials may be submitted. No hand-written content, except for signatures is allowed.

A letter of support from the community partner, a Girl Scout is working with on her Gold Award project, must accompany her Gold Award Proposal.

- It must be on the community partner's letterhead and should describe the anticipated benefits of your project.
- The letter should also make it clear that the organization is aware that you are working on your Gold Award project. An original handwritten signature must also be on the letter.
- Upload letter in Go Gold Online and submit with the proposal.
