As a Girl Scout adult volunteer, I agree to:

- Treat every girl and adult with respect and be sensitive to their needs.
- Respect the places and the people with whom I come in contact in my role as a Girl Scout Adult Volunteer.
- Not initiate or participate in gossip or negative statements about Girl Scouts and will refrain from behavior that may undermine the leadership of an activity or the troop/group. Should I have a complaint or problem, I will follow the proper chain of command.
- Use and follow agreed-upon safety policies and procedures, including all troop rules/procedures.
- Supervise, mentor, and keep all Girl Scouts safe with which I am working, not just my own.
- Teach and assist only when necessary. It is not any volunteer's job to do the work for the girls.
- Keep cell-phone use to a minimum while supervising and working with girls
- Refrain from smoking, vaping, alcohol consumption, and drug use.
