for Troops | 2023 – 2024

April 1 – September 30, 2023

Who's eligible?

Any member or troop with a 2022-2023 membership can renew for the 2023-2024 Girl Scout year.

Why renew now?

It's easy and fast!

Parents, troops, and volunteers can easily renew membership for themselves or their girl(s) online via myGS using a debit or credit card.

How do we pay for our troop to renew?

Many troops choose to use troop funds to register members of the troop (volunteers and girls). Troop funds should be used to sustain the troop and membership registration is a necessity of operating and participating in the troop, so this is an ideal way to use troop funds. Please note that a girl cannot be denied participation due to a family's inability to pay and troop funds should be used to purchase membership for these girls.

What about financial assistance?

Requests for financial assistance must be made by the girl's parent or caregiver via their myGS account. Any existing troop funds should be used before requesting financial assistance for any member.

Make sure your troop is insured at the start of the Membership Year!

One benefit of membership is ensuring that your troop has activity accident insurance for registered members when participating in activities that include incidents at meetings and trips (under three-nights).

Membership prices:

- **\$25 Girl Membership** Single-Year membership for a girl
- **\$25 Adult Membership** Single-Year membership for an adult/volunteer
- **\$200 Young Alumnae Membership** good for life for Girl Scout alumnae under 30
- **\$400 Lifetime Membership** good for life for Girl Scout alumnae over 30, or any non-alumnae adults

More Girl Scout Early Renewal Incentives for Troops

Troops that renew 85% of eligible girls* by 6pm on June 1:

- Each girl receives a GSGLA round lip balm, *color may vary based on vendor inventory.*
- Each troop receives a GSGLA Emergency First Aid kit, *color may vary based on vendor inventory.*



Girls and Leaders in Troops that Renew by 6pm on June 30 will receive an Early Renewal Patch!



Troops that renew 80% or more of eligible girls* by 6pm on June 30 AND submit Annual Year-End Report

- 2 GSGLA adult hats per troop**
color may vary based on vendor inventory.
- 2 cents per cookie box sold in 2024



Troops that renew 75% of eligible girls* by 6pm June 30 AND submit Annual Year-End Report

- 1 cent per cookie box sold in 2024

**Eligible girls include all Girl Scouts currently in TK-11th grade. Registered Girl Scouts that are currently in 12th grade will not count against renewal incentives.*

***Four hats will be provided for troops that have 24+ girls registered*
