Before You Book!

Staff: Each Boating Adventure comes with lifeguard staff who are there to instruct, lifeguard, and take care of the equipment.

Property: Please note that the property is shared with facility renters, and Boy Scout groups may be accessing from the east side. Boating Adventure participants must exit the property within 30 minutes after their session ends unless they have booked additional facility time.

Beach: Boating Adventure participants must remain at the beach for the entire session. Boating shoes are required at all times. Tables and chairs are not provided, but troops may bring their own. Swimming is only permitted with a lifeguard on duty.



Group Size: Groups range from a 10 min-25 max. The count includes both adults and youth who will be on the water at any time. However, adults and youth who are not participating in boating will not be counted toward this total. We kindly ask troops to limit the number of non-participants to minimize distractions for our lifeguard staff.

Tagalongs: Tagalongs are welcome but will count toward the total participant limit. Children under 5 are not permitted on boats for safety reasons.



Parking: Parking for Boating Adventure participants is located in the harbor lot on the other side of Davies Bridge. If you plan to stay overnight, you can park on the blacktop at Marine Landing.

Facility Access:

- 1) Shared restrooms can be accessed from the west entry door to the boat house.
- 2) Outdoor showers are available for rinsing off after the session.
- 3) Renting the facility? Onsite parking for overnight-use and drop offs/pick ups only.
- 4) Boating Adventure participants have full use of the beach for the duration of their session.



Lifeguard Ratios & Pricing

1-10 Boating Participants:	2 Lifeguards	-- \$260
11-15 Boating Participants:	3 Lifeguards	--\$350
16-20 Boating Participants:	4 Lifeguards	-- \$440
20-25 Boating Participants:	5 Lifeguards	--\$530
